➤ ACTS e-Wallet

The ACTS e-Wallet is a new service feature that auto-deducts Import Storage and Import Reefer charges from the ACTS user's e-Wallet balance. This feature will be applicable to containers with trucks that are in-yard awaiting exit but are subject to additional payment.

This new ACTS feature aims to eliminate trucks being blocked at the exit gates due to expired storage and reefer charges.
