DRIVER SMS ALERT SYSTEM

- Drivers will receive an **SMS notification** whenever the DEA, X-Ray, or any BOC hold is lifted from their container
- Once they receive this text notification, **they can exit the terminal**
- This alert system helps drivers make sure there are **no impediments prior to gate-out**



During the Truck Manifesting process, input your driver's cellphone number in the **Truck Driver Mobile#** field.
