Please be advised that MICT remains **operational** as we continue to monitor the course of Typhoon EGAY (Doksuri). As of this writing:

- There are no vessels alongside due to the Sea Travel Advisory of the Philippine Coast Guard released last July 24 mandating the suspension of all vessel movement (see attachment); and
- Yard and Gate Operations continue to serve all truck transactions.

As usual, all safety measures are in place to keep the terminal secure during the inclement weather.

Please stay tuned for further updates on our Port Schedule should there be any changes.
